- 12:30 PM CST Arrive in **Chicago** at the **Museum of Science and Industry,** the largest science museum in the Western Hemisphere, It offers over 800 captivating interactive exhibits including the U-505 submarine, the only German U-Boat in the US, a working coal mine, a Boeing 727 airplane, and much, much more. - 11:30 AM Transfer to the **Magnificent Mile** and **Water Tower Place**, Chicago's seven floor shopping mall for shopping and lunch on your own. This iconic Chicago street runs the length of Michigan Avenue from the Chicago River to Lake Shore Drive, and is the heart of the city's shopping district. Here, posh brand name stores stand alongside historic and luxury hotels and landmarks such as the Water Tower and Pumping Station, one of the few structures left standing after the Great Chicago Fire of 1871. 845 North Michigan Avenue
- 1:30 PM Arrive at the **Field Museum of Natural History,** home to over 26 million artifacts, including *Sue*, the world's largest, most complete T. rex. Transfer to **Symphony Center** to enjoy the concert! While visiting orchestras, lecturers, and jazz artists feature on its program, this center is first and foremost home of the Chicago Symphony Orchestra. This complex holds a main stage, recital hall, and a restaurant names Rhapsody. 220 South Michigan Avenue

8:00 PM Enjoy a performance by the world renowned Chicago Symphony Orchestra (\$64 allotted) at Symphony Center. Norwegian pianist Leif Ove Andsnes brings his "effortless command and penetrating clarity" (*The New York Times*) to Britten's Piano Concerto, a glittering score composed during the lead-up to World War II. Riccardo Muti frames the program with Richard Strauss' contemplative "Dreaming by the Fireside," from his opera Intermezzo, and Schumann's triumphant Fourth Symphony. Muti, Andsnes & Britten Piano Concerto Riccardo Muti, conductor Leif Ove Andsnes, piano *R. Strauss* Symphonic Interlude No. 2 from *Intermezzo* Britten

- 10:00 AM Arrive at the **Shedd Aquarium,** one of the world's largest indoor aquariums. The facility houses more than 32,600 aquatic animals representing some 1,500 species of fishes, reptiles, amphibians, invertebrates, birds and mammals from around the world. Be sure to visit the re-imagined **Oceanarium**, a world-class marine mammal pavilion with beluga whales, dolphins, sea otters, sea lions, and penguins. 1200 South Lake Shore Drive

- 12:30 PM Arrive at **Millennium Park,** a sparkling downtown green space, adjacent to Grant Park, and the crown jewel of Chicago's 7,600-plus acres of parkland. Take pictures of the city's skyline dramatically reflected in sculptor Anish Kapoor's **"Cloud Gate"** sculpture (known to locals and tourists alike simply as "The Bean") and admire Frank Gehry's whimsical outdoor concert pavilion, the most sophisticated outdoor concert venue of its kind in the United States. 55 North Michigan Avenue
- 1:30 PM Finally, enjoy time at **Navy Pier,** 50 acres of parks and promenades, gardens, shops, eateries and attractions. Not only experience breathtaking views of the skyline, but ride on the 150-foot-high Ferris wheel, spin on an old-fashioned musical carousel, ride the Wave Swinger, enjoy an 18-hole miniature golf course, or catch a 3D movie at the IMAX Theater, featuring a six-story-high, 80-foot-wide screen.
