Champion Middle School 22/23 School Year New Dress Code Guidelines

Students are NOT required to wear uniforms. However, all students are required to dress in such a way that it is not distracting to the educational process. The school reserves the right to prohibit any clothing or apparel that may potentially disrupt or cause a safety concern in the school environment.

Examples of prohibited items include but are not limited to:

- · Tank tops, Halter Tops, Low-Cut Tops and Spaghetti Straps
- · Bare midriffs
- · Neck lines that display any cleavage
- · See-through tops (undergarments must not be seen Note: tights, leggings, hosiery
- and underwear qualify as undergarments)
- \cdot Bra straps must not show or be visible outside of clothing
- \cdot Shorts, skirts, or skorts must not be too short. Mid thigh is acceptable
- · Torn jeans/clothes, holes must be sewn or patched
- · Frayed jeans must not show skin or undergarments
- · Large purses or bags
- · Pajama bottoms or look-a-likes, including Spirit Wear
- · Sagging pants; pants are to be worn at the waist
- · Spiked items and chains, loose or sewn on
- · Gloves, full or fingerless
- · Hats, bandanas or hoodies (hoods worn on head)

• Apparel that displays ads or promotions of a sexual nature, alcoholic beverages, tobacco or any other drug, or which advocates violence of the use of force against any institution, individual , racial, ethnic or cultural group.

*Specific procedures regarding dress code will be reviewed with students during class meetings and assemblies at the beginning of the school year, as well as reviewed throughout the school year.
