The school doors open for breakfast from 7:00 am- 7:25 am. Students remain outside until breakfast begins. The school day for middle and high school students is 7:30 am-2:30 pm. Students must be in their classrooms ready for instruction by 7:35 am; otherwise, they are tardy.

I would like to take this time to introduce myself to some and reintroduce myself to others. I am the new director and high school principal of Columbus Africentric Early College. We are three schools on one campus. The previous director, Dr. Todd Walker, is now the Chief of curriculum for the district. I have devoted most of my 29 years of educational experiences to Columbus City Schools, serving as an elementary and middle school teacher, Assistant Principal, or Principal in an elementary, middle, or high school in various buildings throughout the district. Mr. Warren is the new middle school principal of Africentric, Dr. John Stegall is the new high school assistant principal, and Carmen Turner is our elementary principal. Together, we will serve the students of CAEC.

Although job titles have charged, we look forward to parental collaboration and community support as we build upon the continuum that provides a safe, clean, engaging, stimulating, and motivating environment that sets the standard for learning.

We expect ALL students to wear dress code. Middle school students will continue to wear purple collar shirts (long or short sleeves) with khaki pants (NO SAGGING), dresses, skirts, or jumpers. Legwear (tights) or socks are restricted to solid, purple, black, or white. The same pertains to high school students except for black collared shirts. The school will also have some sweatshirts available to sell. We will accept no other layered options for students to wear during the school day. The dress code is strictly enforced. Cell phones will have classroom restrictions, and students must place backpacks, outerwear, coats, etc., in their secured, assigned locker. Unsecured items are at risk for theft and vandalism, for which the school is not liable.
