



## **Requirements for Earning the Seal of Student Engagement from Columbus City Schools:**

Columbus City Schools wants to encourage every student to be engaged in some type of curricular, or extra-curricular activity. In order to earn the Student Engagement Seal, a student must participate in extracurricular activities such as athletics, clubs, student government inclusive of three meaningful experiences focusing on various elements of 21st century skills (critical thinking, creativity, collaboration, communication, information literacy, media literacy, technology literacy, flexibility, leadership, initiative, productivity, and social skills). Students must engage in the experiences over the course of their high school career.
