❖ Expectations

Students are expected to adhere to three expectations:

❖ Folders

Each student will have their own folder. The LEFT pocket is for incomplete work. New assignments and make-up work are on the left side. The RIGHT pocket is the work that has been completed and returned to the student.

❖ Homework

Homework assignments are given to reinforce the lessons that are taught in class. .

❖ Make Up Work

If a student is absent from class, it is the responsibility of the student to obtain make-up work and return it in a timely manner.

❖ Grading Policy

Student grades are based on the accumulation of points. Points are based on: class work, homework, and assessments. Students may lose points on late assignments or make-up work. An EXAMPLE of the point break down is a follows:

- Tests: 10 points each
- Quizzes: 1 point per question
- Notes: 1 points per lesson
- Homework: 1 points per assignment
- Class work/Projects: points vary based on assignment
