Homework Policy

- Homework may be given 1-2 times per week. Expect about 45 minutes each night if assigned. However, we do much of our work/projects in the classroom as groups, and there may be weeks at a time with no take home assignment.
- In the case of an excused absence, homework should be turned in the day you arrive back at school. Students are responsible for copying the homework assignments off the homework board each day and into their planners. Parents should monitor the homework planners, but it is not necessary to sign them.

Independent Reading Program

• Students will be expected to read several novels independently throughout the school year. They will need to do a book review for each book. The Columbus Metropolitan Library will provide the books, as well as the AIMS library.

Interactive ELA/Social Studies Notebook

- These must be spiral notebooks, college ruled, 150 sheets or more, and a non-tearable cover. Your student will be taking notes for my subjects 3-4 days a week.
- Tests and quizzes will mostly be given with the open notebook policy.
- Notebooks will be evaluated at the end of each quarter on completeness, neatness, organization, and creativity.
- The notebooks are data driven, meaning your student will be required to save most of their assessments and assignments for the quarter.
- The process of keeping good notes not only teaches students to process written information and content area data collection. It also teaches them organizational skills.

RICA, or Reading in the Content Areas

• This is an identified period of intervention and enrichment built into the middle school schedule for 2020-2021. RICA is a direct response to the Community Research Partners Survey results, which indicated the need for a flexible period of intervention for middle school students. I will hold office hours from 1:45-2:30P, and use this period as a study hall until we return.
