

Physical Education Syllabus 6.1

Welcome to the gym! I am so glad to have you in class. We are going to have the best 9 weeks. I am here to help you reach some personal goals, as well as teach/re-teach some of the State of Ohio's Physical Education Standards. In order to be successful it is imperative that you come to class each day with the requested items and an attitude to learn.

Materials that AIMS provides:

1. State of Ohio Assessment sheets. Yes there is homework and mandatory writing for your successful completion of this class.
2. A virtual classroom and platform to learn with Ms. Schemmel

Items that you will need to bring:

1. IT IS A MUST that you have tennis shoes on to participate. This is a non-negotiable.
2. Bring a pencil to write with every day. Or your google docs
3. Any medications for safe activity participation. Ex.(Inhaler in the Nurses office with Dr. Permission)
4. Lastly, if you are ill or injured, please bring an excuse note explaining your condition and or limits for participation. If it persists longer than 3 days I will ask for a Drs. Note. This is still important for virtual learning.

Daily procedures

1. Log in to your assigned zoom class on time Monday - Thursday. Make sure you are visible and that your first and last name appear on your square. You may be held in the waiting room or not admitted if you do not follow those expectations.
2. Check in by email with questions outside of class time. I will respond within 24 hours. Keep in mind, I have over 150 students this 9 weeks. You are important to me and so is your concern.
3. Grades are based on daily participation, following directions, safety and coming to class prepared. Yes, this includes virtually.

Students will perform basic skills and tactics that are developmentally appropriate in at least one activity from the following categories of sport: invasion games, net/wall games, fielding/run-scoring games, and/or target games. Students will successfully participate in sport demonstrating skills of the game and applying the tactics, knowledge and concepts of the game.

4. Students will complete all written State Assessments and turn them in on assigned due dates to receive credit. Failure to turn in classwork or homework can affect your final grade.
