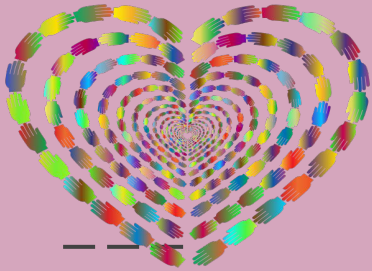

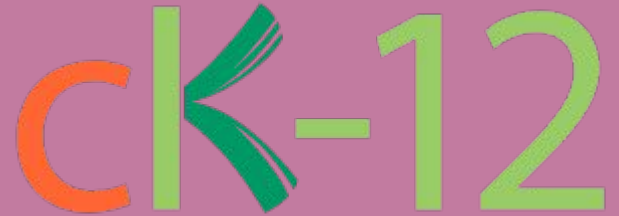

Remote Learning Schedule

Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, Fridays:

- Zoom Lessons
- Will be following your regular schedule

Wednesdays:

- Students will independently be working towards their weekly goal of 220 minutes of work for each subject area. Each teacher will assign and specify the work that is to be completed during this time.
- Teachers will hold office hours at specific times for students to receive help.

Classroom Expectations

Before Class:

Be sure to read posted agendas and announcement. Be prepared for class by having all your virtual programs ready and other materials you need for that particular class.

During Class:

- To be admitted to the Zoom, your username must be your full name.
- On Zoom, you must remain muted unless it is your turn to use the mic.
- Use the comments ONLY for questions related to class or when prompted by the teacher.
- Conduct yourself appropriately over all virtual programs (Zoom, Google Classroom, etc).

Other:

- Use your student email (studentid@columbus.k12.oh.us)
- Be a problem solver!



Classroom Expectations: Uniform
