**SCHOOL MISSION:** Each student is highly educated, prepared for leadership and service, and empowered for success as a citizen in a global community.

**DRESS CODE:** The uniform dress code includes tan, navy, or black pants, capris, shorts, skirts, or skorts (no denim). Shorts and skorts must be fingertip length or longer. 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## **SPECIAL LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES/CURRICULUM:**

In addition to an emphasis on reading, writing, and language/word study, Scottwood offers a strong curriculum, which includes, math, science, social studies, health art, music (vocal and instrumental), and physical education. Our curriculum is directly aligned with Ohio State Learning Standards. All students receive a Chromebook with full access to curriculum materials.

Scottwood uses Into Reading from HMH as their reading program. Into Reading has books for in-school reading as well as stories that are available virtually for the computer for at-home reading. Our K-2 students receive Foundations Phonics instruction as well as the Heggerty program to enhance phonemic awareness. We do a quarterly writing competition to teach the writing process and to showcase our Scottwood Writers. Students' progress is monitored through the IReady computer program and they are instructed in small groups on grade level.

ESL: Scottwood has students representing 26 different countries from around the world. We have a full ESL department to help meet the needs of our students whose first language is not English.

GIFTED AND TALENTED PROGRAM: All students from K-2 participate in the PETS program. Those students needing extra enrichment will receive pull-out services to meet their needs.

## **STUDENT ACTIVITIES/SPORTS:**

Students participate in Scottwood's annual talent show and concerts. In addition, they attend field trips to BIZtown, Metropark SEED program, Columbus Art Museum, COSI, Legoland, Pumpkin Patch, and more. Career Day allows students to explore a variety of careers that may interest them in the future.

Our school has PAWS, which stands for: **P**repared for School, **A**lways Respectful, **W**orking Hard, **S**afe Hands Safe Feet Safe School.

## **FAMILY SUPPORT & RESOURCES:**

Our annual Ice Cream Social gives families an opportunity to visit our school and meet teachers. Scottwood hosts a widely attended Family Literacy Night and a book fair to encourage reading every year. Families are invited to award assemblies, classroom activities, and concerts. International Day is celebrated to give families a chance to participate in and share a variety of cultural traditions, music, food, and dress.
