SCHOOL VISION: Buckeye Middle School's vision is to ensure that each student is academically prepared for high school and a post-secondary education along with having a career focus. DRESS CODE: We have a DAILY uniform as follows:

<u>Tops</u>: Students will wear a short or long sleeve polo in the color designated for their grade level: 6th - RED, 7th - BLACK, 8th - GRAY. In cooler months, they may wear a crew neck sweatshirt, also in the color designated for their grade level. NO hooded sweatshirts (hoodies).

<u>Bottoms</u>: Students may wear BLACK uniform shorts, pants, skirts, shorts, or jumpers. Skirts and shorts must fall below the finger tips. NO cargo, denim material, leggings, jeggings, joggers, or sweatpants. Shoes: Student may wear their shoes of choice.

We also offer Core and Encore Enrichment courses.
