**DRESS CODE:** CCPSB scholars wear a mandatory uniform.

- **Official Uniform:** Long or short sleeve white or maroon Oxford cloth button-up shirt with the school crest, tie appropriate to the grade level, black pants (no jeans), black belt, all black shoes, black sweater vest with the school logo (sweater vest is optional). Shirts must be tucked in at all times.
- **Unofficial Uniform:** Long or short sleeve, black, maroon or white, polo shirt with the school crest, black pants or walking shorts (walking shorts may be worn during the 1<sup>st</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grading periods only) (no jeans), black belt, all black shoes.
