WHAT MAKES OUR SCHOOL OUTSTANDING

Students are instructed at their grade level and guided in reaching their full potential. All students participate in our building wide discipline program – Eakin Eagle Traits. SPECIALTY LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES/CURRICULUM

Reading, math, English as a Second Language, science, social studies, health, art, music and physical education is aligned to Ohio's Learning Standards. Students have an opportunity to use chrome books, thin client computers, Smart Boards and other technology in the classroom. (We are working towards having 1:1 computer access).

READING PROGRAM: Students are instructed at their level and the program is supplemented with additional materials to support students' growth. Small group tutoring is offered to students in grades 1-3. Students in grades 4-5 are provided instruction that is Researched Based.
