East High School, the proud home of the Tigers, features the distinguished Health Sciences Academy, which incorporates the Project Lead the Way Curriculum. This dynamic medical program provides a rigorous pathway designed to equip students for exceptional careers in the medical and healthcare fields, with a strong emphasis on advanced Science and Math learning. Through our College Credit Plus partnership with Columbus State Community College, students can earn college credits while still in high school. Additionally, East High has adopted the Universal Design for Learning Model, a framework that effectively addresses barriers and supports the development of expert learners within diverse instructional settings.
