**DRESS CODE:** Students are expected to follow Dress Code outlined in the District's Guide to Student Success.

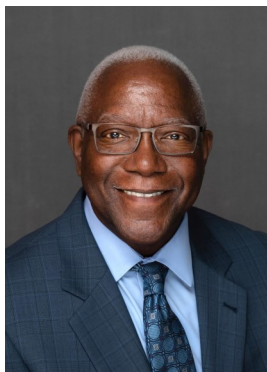
## WHAT MAKES THIS SCHOOL OUTSTANDING

The graduating class of 2020 earned over \$2,603,204.00 by rewarding scholarships, grants, and other awards. East became an ACT testing site five years ago to encourage students to test early and often. Our numerous partnerships provide a variety of opportunities for students to gain access to resources that enhance their overall educational experience. East continues to demonstrate excellence in academics and athletics. Our outstanding marching band and drill team has toured all over the country performing on Black Entertainment Television and in many marching band competitions in Kentucky, Indiana, and Michigan. The Marching Tigers are the single school organization that has sent the most students from East High to two and four-year colleges over the last several decades. The band continues to produce the most students with perfect attendance, honor roll, super honor roll, and superior honor roll. East High supports the district-wide Literacy Initiative, which encourages literacy and sustains learning for all students.

## SPECIALTY LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES/CURRICULUM

The historical EAST HIGH SCHOOL, the home of the TIGERS, is also home to the Health Sciences Academy, a unique and celebrated medical program that features the Project Lead the Way Curriculum. The program features a challenging medical pathway platform designed to prepare our students for outstanding career opportunities throughout the medical/health care profession. The program offers exceptional Science and Math learning opportunities. We offer college credit plus courses in partnership with Columbus State Community College, and students can earn college credit while in high school. Our school has embraced the Universal Design for Learning Model. UDL encompasses a framework that addresses the primary barriers to fostering expert learners within instructional environments.
