WHAT MAKES THIS SCHOOL OUTSTANDING:

Indian Springs Elementary School is one of only two schools in the District to be recognized by the Ohio Department of Education with a Momentum Award, a 4.5 out of 5 stars on the state report card, and a Silver Award for our Positive Behavior Supports and Intervention (PBIS) for the 2022-2023 school year. PBIS is a relationship-based system that helps students learn expected behaviors, and at Indian Springs, we promote it through the I.S.E. Way: I-Intelligent, S-Safe, E-Empathetic. This approach fosters intrinsic motivation and positive collaboration, creating an excellent learning environment.

SPECIALTY LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES/CURRICULUM:

Indian Springs provides personalized instruction to help every student reach their full potential. Students engage in a full academic program, with gifted services for grades K-5 and enrichment in art, music, and physical education. The school also supports social-emotional learning through Calm Classroom mindfulness and Zones of Regulation, helping students stay focused and ready to learn.
