SPECIALTY LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES/CURRICULUM

Livingston Elementary provides a hands-on approach to learning using Common Core Standards which enhances student engagement. Our students also have an opportunity to learn using computers throughout the day to enhance their understanding of concepts being studied. Our staff continues to learn best practices to support the social and emotional development of our students. We realize that our students come from a variety of experiences and have diverse needs. We work collaboratively with each other, school partners and our parents to meet the needs of our students and school community. LANGUAGE ARTS PROGRAM: Our curriculum is focused on the Ohio Common Core Learning Standards, integrating content area subjects into reading and writing instruction. Every day, our students are exposed to, and work with a variety of quality fiction and nonfiction texts with read-alouds, small group differentiated instruction, and independent reading. Students also engage in writing across the curriculum and targeted phonics instruction on a daily basis. Students are asked to justify their answers in writing and when speaking with evidence. We continue to push our students to achieve at higher levels and we are confident in their abilities to do so.



STUDENT ACTIVITIES/SPORTS

We have a variety of activities for our students to include Student Counsel, Fan Club, Girls on the Run, Techie Club, Junior Achievement, and monthly Positive Behavioral Interventions and Support (PBIS) celebrations. Livingston students can also participate in an after-school program that runs five days per week at school with our Boys and Girls Club partners. In addition, guests from Nationwide Children's Hospital support our second and third grade students for tutoring two days per week to support reading intervention.

FAMILY SUPPORT and RESOURCES

Parents work as partners at Livingston Elementary School. Parents attend school events, field trips, and our Livingston Parent University monthly sessions. We welcome our families as partners in education and appreciate everything that our families do to support their child and our school community. In addition, Livingston has a family ambassador and a parent organization known as the "LLC."
