SPECIALTY LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES/CURRICULUM:

The curriculum offerings at Northland High School are designed for 100% student success. We offer fourteen school-based, dual credit college courses through a partnership with Columbus state. Students who participate in the Credits Count program are eligible for college scholarships upon graduation. The AVID (Advancement Via Individual Determination) courses are provided in grades 9-12. We have three language offerings: Spanish, French, and American Sign Language. Advanced Placement courses are offered in Biology, English language and Composition, English Literature and Composition, and Environmental Science. We also offer a full complement of STEM-focused courses including Discovery of Engineering, Introduction to Engineering, Digital Electronics, Computer Integrated Manufacturing, Coding, and Financial Literacy.
