GIRLS: <u>Tops</u>, white, yellow or light blue in color with no pictures or writing. Button up blouses short or long sleeve, turtlenecks, or polo type shirts are preferable. Navy blue or white cardigan sweaters may be worn over the shirts. <u>Bottoms</u>, Navy blue or tan jumpers, skirts or skorts at an appropriate length, shorts appropriate length (weather permitting), or pants. Socks: Navy blue or white. Shoes: No open toe shoes, flip-flops, clogs, shoes with wheels, crocs or heels. Gym shoes are to be worn on gym day.

BOYS: <u>Tops</u>, white, yellow or light blue in color with no pictures or writing. Button up dress shirts short or long sleeved, turtlenecks, or polo shirts are preferable. Navy blue or white cardigan sweaters may be worn over the shirts. <u>Bottoms</u>, Navy blue or tan shorts, appropriate length (weather permitting), trousers or slacks. Socks: Navy blue or white. Shoes: No open toe shoes, shoes with wheels, crocs or sandals. Gym shoes must be worn on gym day
