SPECIAL LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES/CURRICULUM

Weinland Park Elementary uses Columbus City Schools' reading program based on the Ohio's Learning Standards. This program deepens reading comprehension through guided reading, phonics, vocabulary, reading fluency, and writing. During the 90-minute math learning block, students are engaged in authentic, hands-on math activities that challenge their thinking. Every student receives 30 minutes of social studies, science, and writing instruction daily. PRE-KINDERGARTEN: Weinland Park offers full-day Pre-Kindergarten classes to 4-year-olds in a general education classroom and inclusion classroom.

STUDENT ACTIVITIES/SPORTS

Godman Guild offers an on-site after-school program to serve K-5 students. Limited spaces are available.
