The curriculum is aligned with the Ohio State Standards. Our staff strives to challenge students to perform at their highest level as is evidenced by our Ohio State Assessment scores.

READING PROGRAM: Teachers will use the HMH Into Reading program which is aligned to the Ohio State Learning Standards. K-2 teachers all use Foundations for phonics instruction. Kindergarten teachers will also be using the Heggerty Curriculum to support phonemic awareness.
