WHAT MAKES THIS SCHOOL OUTSTANDING

Walnut Ridge is located in an urban setting within the far east section of Columbus. Columbus is the state capital as well as the corporate headquarters for several large insurance and specialty companies. The Ohio State University is also located in Columbus.

Walnut Ridge is a four-year comprehensive high school with an enrollment of 800. It is accredited by the Department of Education of the State of Ohio. It is an integrated public high school with student representation from 27 countries. The Columbus City Schools system is one of the most outstanding urban school systems in the United States.

Class of 2020 had senior success rate of 90% earning \$1.8 million in scholarships. Over 60% of our graduates plan to attend a 2 or 4-year university.

The high school staff is composed of 40 teachers with over 50% having Master's degrees or advanced professional degrees.

SPECIALITY LEARNING/CURRICULUM

Walnut Ridge offers Advanced Placement courses in biology, human geography, Spanish and government. Accelerated English courses are offered in ninth and tenth grade. This uses technology and available resources to individualize instruction for students in the core academic courses. We also offer Career Tech NCCR, CPR and coding classes on campus.
