 - The Boxer Rebellion 1899—1901
 - The Philippine-American War 1899—1902
 - The Mexican Revolution 1910--1920
 - The Russian Revolution 1917—1918
 - The Chinese Revolution 1949
 - The Cuban Revolution 1953—1959gf
 - The Singing Revolution 1988—1991
 - The Revolutions of 1989 (Poland, Hungary and Berlin)
- 2. Create a 10 slide Google presentation that includes the following:
- A. A title slide showing the topic, your name and an appropriate background image.
- B. Where, when and why this revolt took place?
- C. What groups were involved in this revolt and its leaders? What roles did they play?
- D. A timeline and descriptions of the major events associated with this revolution.
- E. What societal, political and economic changes resulted from this revolt?
- F. What individuals and groups were effected and who was impacted the most by this revolt.
- G. A primary source (Quote, picture, chart, cartoon, etc.) and a statement of what it tells us about this revolution.
- H. How this revolution impacted American History.
- I. A summary of your opinions about this revolution and its legacy.
- J. A citation slide showing at least 3 sources used in your presentation.

3. General instructions

Your slide show should be informative, effective and creative. It is recommended that you include a picture, image or other visual aid on as many slides as possible.

This assignment is worth a possible 100 total points with each slide assessed 0 to 10 points based on the following criteria:
