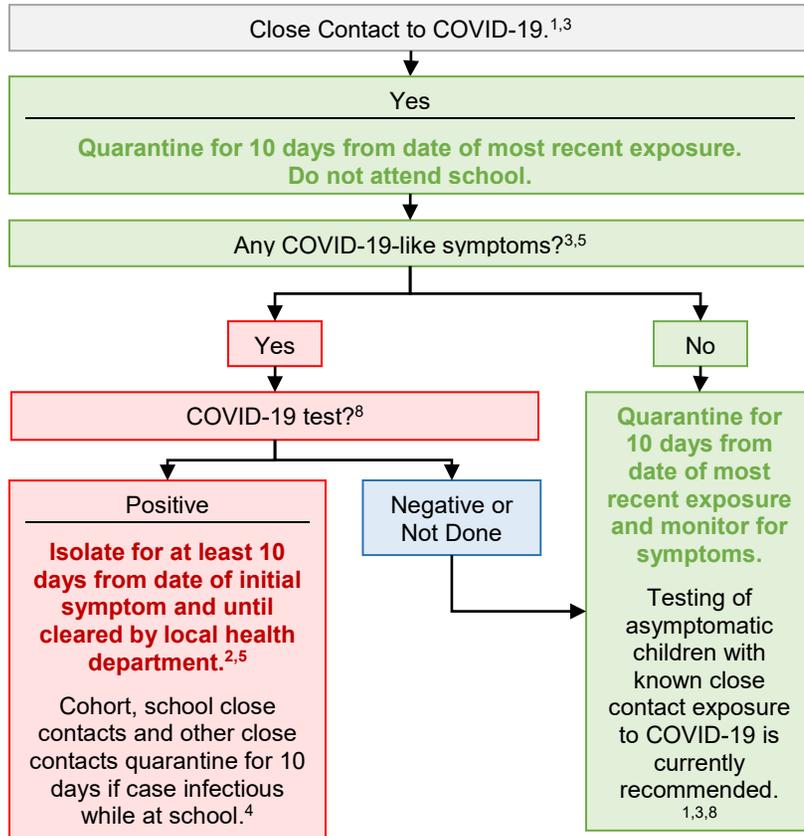


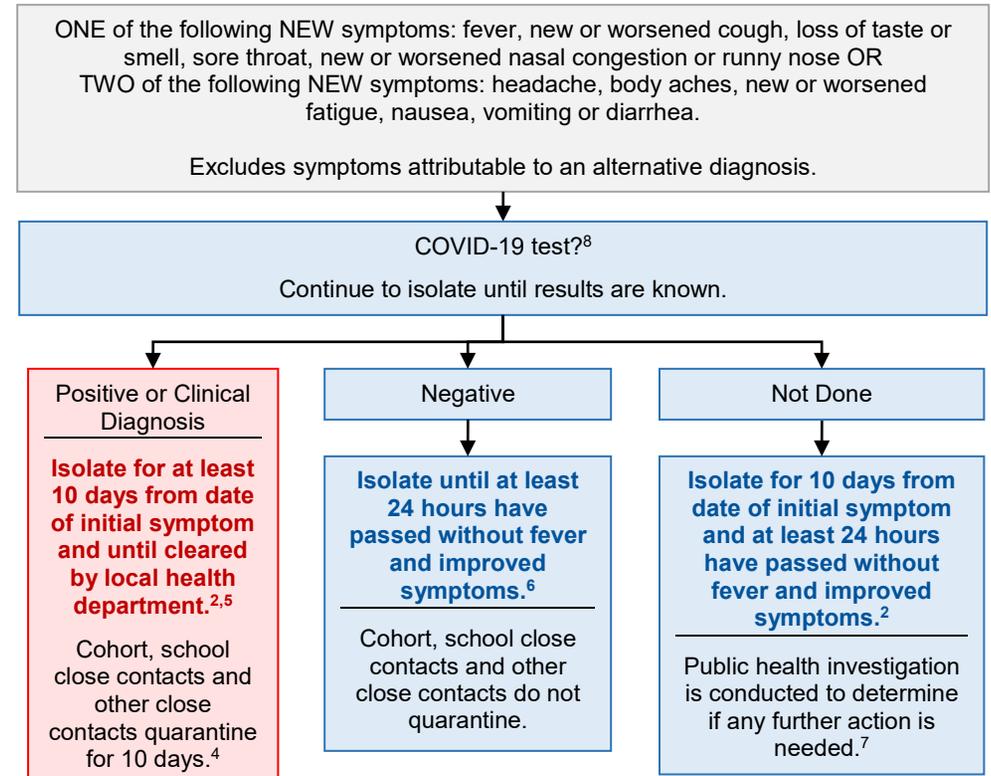
# School & Child Care COVID-19 Isolation & Quarantine Protocol

12/9/2020

## IF EXPOSED TO KNOWN COVID-19 CASE, START HERE:



## IF SYMPTOMATIC, START HERE:



<sup>1</sup> Anyone who was within 6 feet of someone diagnosed with COVID-19 for at least 15 minutes with or without a mask is a close contact. In addition, anyone who was in a cohort, classroom or team with someone diagnosed with COVID-19 may be considered a close contact.

<sup>2</sup> Individual must isolate for at least 10 days from date of initial symptom and until 24+ hours without fever and other symptoms improved. Isolation means physical separation from others to prevent exposure.

<sup>3</sup> Individual must quarantine for 10 days from date of most recent exposure to someone with COVID-19. Quarantine means physical separation from others to monitor for symptoms.

<sup>4</sup> Cohort, classroom or team of someone with COVID-19 may quarantine for 10 days from date of most recent exposure. Quarantine means physical separation from others to monitor for symptoms.

<sup>5</sup> Symptoms may include, but are not limited to: fever, subjective fever, cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, chills, fatigue, headache, body aches, congestion, runny nose, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, abdominal pain, loss of taste or loss of smell.

<sup>6</sup> Other diagnoses may include, but are not limited to: allergies, asthma, common cold, croup, influenza, parainfluenza, pertussis and strep throat.

<sup>7</sup> Since no diagnosis is confirmed, public health conducts an investigation to determine other epidemiologic links or causes of illness. Dependent upon the outcome of the investigation, the cohort, classroom or team of the symptomatic individual may still need to quarantine.
