

JUNIORS, WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?



Due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic there are many unknowns, but here's what you can do now to prepare for college:

- 01** Visit act.org for testing updates and to register for future tests.
- 02** Finish junior year strong by staying on top of your coursework. Colleges will only see grades through the end of junior year on your applications.
- 03** Explore college campuses through virtual and, if available, in-person visits and keep notes to reference when making your college selection decisions.
- 04** Begin researching and recording scholarship opportunities and requirements.
- 05** Identify teachers, coaches, and/or advisors who may be able to write a letter of recommendation for you.
- 06** Visit CommonApp.org (or download the app to your mobile device) and consider creating an account.
- 07** Begin brainstorming your personal statement and ideas for your Common App essay prompt.
- 08** Stay in touch with your school counselor and I Know I Can Advisor and notify them immediately if and when you need help.
