



Third Grade Reading Guarantee (3GRG)

Promotion Score for 2022-2023

State law requires the State Board of Education to annually increase the promotion score on Ohio's State Test for grade 3 English language arts until it reaches proficient for the 2024-2025 school year. Accordingly, the State Board voted to raise the promotion score for grade 3 English language arts to 685 for the 2022-2023 school year. **Any student who scores 685 or higher on the English language arts scaled score will be eligible for promotion to fourth grade at the end of the 2022-2023 school year.**

In addition, the Ohio Department of Education has set the reading subscore alternative assessment score for Ohio's State Test for grade 3 English language arts at 47 for the 2022-2023 school year. **Any student who scores 47 or higher on the reading subscore will be eligible for promotion to fourth grade at the end of the 2022-2023 school year, even if the student scores below 685 on Ohio's State Test for grade 3 English Language Arts.**

The i-Ready alternative pathway for 3GRG:

A student has to score a minimum of 510 on i-Ready to be considered for promotion.

Future assessment opportunities for 3rd Grade students:

- **OST ELA - March 31 - April 28, 2023**
 - Results are expected to arrive in district the week of May 22nd.
- i-Ready Reading Assessment (May 1 - June 1, 2023)

SUMMER TESTING OPPORTUNITIES:

- **OST ELA:** June 28, 2023 - At summer school sites.
- **i-Ready Assessment:** Grade 3 students will also have **one** i-Ready testing opportunity during the summer months.
 - **Woodcrest ES only:** Tuesday, July 25th
 - **Traditional Elementary Schools:** Tuesday, August 22nd
