*Please keep in mind that these supplies are needed **every day** and should be replenished through the school year as needed.*

Every Eighth Grade Student needs:

- All students are required to have their Chromebook fully charged every day (or charging cord)
- Optional paper planner
- **2 Master brand** combination locks, (one for hallway locker, one for gym locker)
- Pencil box/pouch, 12 count colored pencils, scissors, ruler (standard metric, unbreakable), 1 box #2 pencils, 1 large or 3 small glue sticks, & hand held pencil sharpener, inexpensive ear buds/headphones

<p>Physical Education</p>	<p>TENNIS SHOES–NO CROCS - shoes that they will need to participate in everyday (not new ones that they won't run in)</p> <p>CLOTHING - Athletic wear. Students will need to participate daily and they may change into appropriate clothing if needed. <p>Computer Class - Moore</p>	<p>Wired headphones or earbuds (no bluetooth), a two-pocket folder, pencil, 2 boxes of tissue.</p>
<p>Vocal music-Spellman</p>	<p><i>*Concert attire-Black pants or skirt, Choir shirt/black dress shirt, black dress shoes</i></p> <p>1" 3-ring black binder for holding music (To be kept in classroom, dedicated to music)</p> <p>1 wide-ruled notebook for music journal (To be kept in classroom, dedicated to music)</p>

Spanish I - Fugate	<p>1" 3-ring binder with a clear plastic cover (dedicated strictly to Spanish and will be kept in the classroom)</p> <p>6 divider tabs</p> <p>1 pair of earbuds for listening language labs with standard plug (no bluetooth, lightning plug, or USB C) to be left in the classroom and used regularly</p> <p>1 box of 12 colored pencils (to be left in the classroom for use)</p> <p>Pencils (to be replenished throughout the semester)</p> <p>Chromebook - fully charged daily (or carry charging cord)</p>
