



Required School Vaccines for Children

EXTENDED CLINIC HOURS • SEPTEMBER 10-17, 2022

Vaccines protect children from serious diseases, and all K-12 students must be up-to-date on required vaccines for the new school year. **Students who do not have the required vaccinations 14 days* after the start of the school year will not be able to attend classes.** Columbus Public Health offers extended hours to provide up-to-date immunizations so all children can be protected and stay in school.

**The exact date will vary based on the first day of classes for each school or district.*
