Canvas is an exciting tool that has the capability of handling all aspects of the teaching and learning process. Teaching with Canvas

Participants will be introduced to strategies for creating blended learning in their classes both in-person and online. It highlights the advantages of using Canvas such as saving time, increasing student engagement, and improving the feedback loop. The course lets teachers know what they should do to set up their courses at the beginning of the year. Information on the SAMR and Backwards Design models place Canvas in the context of an overall blended learning approach. Other units explain planning for Canvas instruction, creating student learning experiences, and managing classes using technology. Discussion groups and quizzes afford opportunities for learning from other teachers, reflection, and review.
