Hallway

- Speak kindly & softly when walking in the hallway
- Have a pass at all times
- Say excuse me if you bump into someone

- Know and follow hall pass policy
- Have all items you need for class
- Know which doors are for student entry and exit

- Keep hallways clean

- Walk with purpose, always with hall pass
- During drills, be quiet and listen for directions
- Refer people to main entrance as doors are alarmed

- Have all required materials ready for class
- Actively participate in your learning
- Keep assignments organized, complete work on time

- Know that the classroom is a safe space
- Take risks to challenge your learning
- Understand how your actions impact others

- Attend class daily
- Actively participate in your learning
- Ask questions when you don't understand, advocate for yourself

<h2>Cafeteria</h2>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Respect others cultures, foods and eating habits • Use respectful language and volume • Treat cafeteria staff with respect and courtesy 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be prepared with lunch ID number • Sit in designated area • Have a pass ready if you are meeting a teacher or going to library 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Understand that different cultures have different customs • Use all cafeteria equipment appropriately 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tell staff if there is a problem • Keep cafeteria clean at all times, report any damage • Use responsible language and volume
<h2>Library</h2>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Treat resources with care • Listen to the librarian • Keep voices to a whisper 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Replace books after you use them or give them to librarian • Have a pass ready to enter the library • Have all necessary materials with you 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Check for library use and availability before going • Be mindful that the library is community space • Finish all food and drink before entering library 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Respect others space in the library • Use library materials for intended purposes • Remember to return all borrowed materials

Transportation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Respect the driver and assist when asked • Keep voices at an indoor level • Listen to bus driver in case of an emergency 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be on time to your bus morning and afternoon • Know your bus number and stop location • Check for all belongings when exiting the bus 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Accept others cultures and customs • Follows the bus drivers rules and direction 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stay seated, keep seating areas free of trash • Report questionable activity to administrators • Use appropriate language
