Kindergarten Team School Supply List:

Individual Student Supplies: *Please open packaging and WRITE your child's NAME ON each supply itself, such as the scissors blades or individual pencil (with the exception of crayon/marker boxes 😊)*

- 1 set of “emergency clothing” in a plastic bag labeled with your child's name- top, underwear, pants, socks (to be changed out seasonally), in case of bathroom issue, food spillage, mud, etc.
- VELCRO tennis shoes- worn daily for safety at play, NO LACES, PLEASE!
- 1 FULL-SIZED BACKPACK- miniature backpacks are too small to hold everything the children need to carry back & forth from school on a daily/weekly basis
- Sturdy OVER-THE-EAR child-sized (adjustable) headphones with standard 3.5mm plug, no earbuds, please!, for use with ChromeBook & standardized testing in the classroom
- Water bottle with securely-closing “straw-top” for drinking in classroom- (please no twist tops or disposable bottles, which spill in class)
- 1 durable PLASTIC pocket folder- for work papers & fliers sent daily to & from school- (and please SHOW THEM how to slide papers inside to fit)
- 1 heavy-duty nylon zipper supply POUCH- no plastic boxes, as they fall and break, ideal size to fit supplies is approximately 10 in. long x 7 in. high
- 4 WIDE beginner pencils (please write your child's name/initials on each pencil)
- 1 sturdy plastic pencil sharpener with holes for BOTH skinny & fat pencils and a sturdy LID to catch pencil shavings
- 4 large pink erasers
- 3-4 bottles of plain white Elmer's glue or large pack of glue sticks (choice)
- 1 small box of WIDE beginner crayons, 8-16 colors only (your choice)
- 2 boxes of 24 regular crayons- not more than 24 colors (storage & spilling issue)
- 2 boxes of broad-tip Crayola markers- 1 box “Classic” colors & 1 box “Assorted” colors (pastels)
- 1 pair of STURDY, ROUNDED-TIP (blunt) kid scissors
- one 4-pack of DRY-ERASE markers: WIDE (not skinny), *bullet tip preferred (or chisel tip), in any color except yellow, *ERASER for markers optional (helpful but not required)

- one 4-pack of Play Doh- **(full-sized cans, NO MINIATURE cans, plz)**
- 1 box of 3-MIL, Letter-size Thermal Laminating Pouches

- ★ **class SNACK:** We ask that you send a **HEALTHY** snack for **27 students, once EVERY MONTH** (anytime convenient for you each month)--ideally shelf-stable and individually packaged--for easy serving and storage in the classroom.

Suggestions: Goldfish crackers, Pirate's Booty, Cheerios, pretzels, yogurt tubes, granola bars, baby carrots, fruit squeeze-its (**NO fruit CUPS**), Teddy Grahams, fruit snacks, cheese sticks, —**no juice boxes/beverages, no peanut products, please, and nothing too sugary.** **Individual packaging is definitely appreciated but not a requirement.** 😊
