Is Your Student Registered for School?

All children new to Columbus City Schools, or those who are currently enrolled but are changing schools due to a change in their residence, <u>MUST</u> enroll through the Central Enrollment Center located at 430 Cleveland Avenue from 8:30 a.m.-4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. Sherwood School Supply List

Let's start the school year off with each student prepared to do his or her best. Below is a list of some school supplies that will help your child be successful in the building and/or virtually.

- some type of computer (ex: chrome book, laptop, or desktop) ** Though it is possible for students to work by cell phone, we don't recommend it**
- at least 1 USB Flash Drive
- pencils and black or blue pens
- loose-leaf paper or spiral notebooks
- 5 2-pocket folder (one for each subject)
- 1 3-ring binder
- 1 pair of earbuds/headphones
- 1 small pencil sharpener
- 2 yellow highlighters

If there are any other supplies students need for the school year, teachers will give them that information in class when we return to the building.

**Address and Phone Number Updates

Parents it is very important that you **update your phone number and address information**. You have the ability to update this information on the Parent Portal in Infinite Campus. If you have not been receiving text messages, phone call messages, or emails this month this means some or all of your information is not correct in our information system. Title One Information

Sherwood Middle School is a Title One School. As a result, you have the right to know the following information:

- 1. Access to your child's individual performance levels on the statewide assessments.
- 2. Know if your child's school is making progress.
- 3. Know the qualifications of your child's teacher.
- 4. Be informed when and if your child is being taught by a substitute teacher or non-highly qualified teacher longer than four consecutive weeks.
- 5. Know that you may agree/disagree with the limited English Language Program participation of your child and to know his/her progress in Limited English Proficient (LEP) assessments.

Visitors

Due to COVID-19 and state mandated restrictions, there will be no visitors permitted in the building without an appointment from an administrator. Until further notice, there will be **NO EXCEPTIONS** to this security policy. If you do have questions, they may be addressed with an administrator.

Sherwood Middle School Uniform Dress Code Policy 2020-2021

<u>Upon returning to school</u>, all Sherwood students will be expected to be in *full uniform dress code* daily. We believe the **Sherwood Uniform Policy** would accomplish the following:

- 1. Foster a sense of school identity and community.
- 2. Prepare scholars for the expectation related to professional attire that future organizations, institutions of higher learning, and employers will have.
- 3. Ensure that our scholars focus on learning instead of clothing.
- 4. Increase school safety and security by making the presence of visitors/outsiders immediately apparent.
- 5. Reduce the cost of clothing for families.

As always, we ask your support in making our school a model school where learning is our students' primary purpose. The expectations of teachers will be to check all students during HOMEROOM and send uniform violators to the office. Together we can create the Sherwood Learning Zone!

Our school dress code is listed below:

Shirts—Shirts must be collared, appropriately sized, worn tucked in, and a solid color. Approved colors are white, navy blue or black. Solid colored sweaters/crew neck sweatshirts may be worn in cooler weather. Sherwood spirit shirts are also permitted. Hooded sweatshirts and sleeveless shirts are not permitted.

Pants/Slacks – Pants must be appropriately sized and worn with a belt (if there are belt loops on the pants). Solid colors of black, navy blue, or khaki are permitted. Blue Jeans **are not permitted**. Sagging is not allowed in school.

Knee-Length Skirts – Skirts <u>must not</u> be shorter than mid-thigh. Solid colors of black, navy blue, or khaki are permitted. In cooler weather, tights/leggings may be worn under skirts that are not shorter than mid-thigh. Jean skirts are not permitted.

Capris & Shorts – Walking shorts (boys) and knee-length walking shorts/ capris (girls) are to be knee length in solid colors of black, navy blue, or khaki and are permitted.

Shoes/Boots –Shoes must be closed toe and attached/closed at the heel. Rubber soled shoes are preferred. High heeled shoes/boots are not permitted. Heels should be 1 inch or less.

Personal Hygiene – Students are expected to take care of their personal hygiene needs in an appropriate manner at home. The spraying of Axe, perfumes, etc. is not appropriate in the halls or classrooms. If needed, the nurse can assist with hygiene emergencies during the school day.

- Clothing may not be tight or form-fitting.
- Clothing may not be see-through.
- Outdoor apparel is **not to be worn** in the building. This includes hats, gloves, scarves, coats, jackets, fleece jackets, and sunglasses, etc.

Seventh Grade Health News

Ohio law regarding required immunizations needed to enter grade seven now include a booster dose of Tdap vaccine. This vaccine helps protect seventh grade students from tetanus, diphtheria, and pertussis. If your student needs the required immunizations, please plan ahead to avoid missing any scheduled school days and valuable learning time upon our return to the building. To receive the required Tdap vaccinations, parents may:

- 1. Visit your family physician.
- 2. Call the Health Department at 614-645-7417
- Visit the Nationwide Children's Hospital Mobile Unit from 8:00-3:00 pm at all locations;
 <u>Tuesdays</u> South HS; <u>Wednesdays</u> East HS and Woodward Park MS; <u>Thursdays</u> West HS.

Once completed, parents must bring in proof of the completed immunization (official immunization record, or a signed statement from the clinic) record on a physician letterhead.
