- The CCS Digital Academy is self-paced, student led, with teacher supervision and flexibility, for students in grades k-12. Remote learning is teacher led instruction.
- CCS Digital Academy is staffed by certified CCS teachers.
- CCS Digital Academy is a semester-long commitment. Once school begins on September 8, students must remain in the CCS Digital Academy through at least the first two quarters of the school year.
- Students will be permitted to return to their original school upon withdrawing from the CCS
 Digital Academy. Students will not lose their lottery spots for the 2020-2021 school year if
 they choose to attend the Digital Academy.
- CCS Digital Academy students are permitted in participate in CCP, Career Center programing, as well as extracurricular activities at their home school.
- Families have until Monday, September 7th, at 5:00pm to unenroll from the Digital Academy. You can do so by sending an email to centralenrollment@columbus.k12.oh.us.
- Enrollment into the CCS Digital Academy is closed at this time. Families interested in enrolling in the Digital Academy will have the opportunity to do so second semester.
- Chromebooks and/or hot spots will be made available to students of the Digital Academy from the home school of enrollment. Please follow up with school about pick up times.
- CCS Digital Academy students in grades K-5 will be enrolled in Edgenuity, while students in grades 6-12 will be enrolled in Apex learning systems.
- General supplies (pens, paper, pencils, crayons), are the supplies needed for the CCS Digital Academy.
- CCS Digital Academy students in grades K-3 will receive workbooks. Workbooks will be scheduled for distribution at later date.
- Schedules for CCS Digital Academy students are created by the counselors at the home school of enrollment. CCS Digital Academy may not offer all courses available at students' home school, but students will be scheduled in all classes required for their designate grade level.
- CCS Digital Academy currently does not provide Gifted services.
- CCS Digital Academy students with IEP's will be supported by the Intervention Specialist from the student's home school of enrollment.
- CCS Digital Academy students and families have the flexibility to create a schedule that fits their lifestyle.

- CCS Digital Academy students and/or parents will check in daily using the student or parent portal.
- The following are recommendations to ensure student success: Kindergarten students would require an average of 2.5 hours daily. 1st 8th grade students are recommended to spend 4-6 hours a day totaling 920 hours for the year. 9th 12th grade students are recommended to spend approximately an hour a day per subject and are required to attend a minimum of 4 (four) synchronous sessions per week. According to APEX, it is recommended that students complete approximately 4.5 hours per course per week. Students that adhere to this guideline should be on track for course completion for most courses.
- Breakfast and lunch will be available at the feeding site closest to your home. Further information on locations and pick up times will be made available to you.
