We are happy to welcome you to the 2023-2024 school year! This school year brings excitement with the **complete renovation** of Hamilton STEM Academy! We hope these changes will foster an even greater climate of success for our students and engage our families and community partners to further our District's mission. We are looking forward to a productive partnership with you to ensure our children can achieve their highest potential. We recognize that in order to be successful in school, our children need support from both the home and school. On behalf of the staff at Hamilton, we will be working with you and your child/children on the following goals:

- Improving our academics in the areas of Reading and Math for all students
- Working to increase our daily attendance rate for every grade
- Building a positive climate and culture surrounding our PBIS (Positive Behavioral Interventions & Supports).

We want to invite each and every one of you to take on an active role in your student's educational experience as we strive for continuous improvement. Last year we started a Parent Teacher Organization (PTO) and we welcome your participation! This year, we are looking forward to engaging our families within our Hamilton School community so that we can develop collaborative, successful partnerships which will support our students in and out of school! We expect all of our staff, students, and families to create an effective two-way communication system between school and home so that we can maximize the resources and supports available to our Hamilton families!

Hamilton STEM Academy is a **Title One school which strongly encourages** *Parent Involvement*. We will discuss the requirements and services at upcoming PTO meetings. We are excited about working with you on improving Hamilton, and better preparing our children for the 21st Century. We are always looking for ways to improve and build so that <u>Together Everyone Achieves More!</u>

The district mission statement, "Each student is highly educated, prepared for leadership and service, and empowered for success as a citizen in a global community" is the driving force behind our work.

The Hamilton Hawk family will have some new faces within the building that you will see often! Teachers joining our staff this year include: Mrs. Murphy Kindergarten, Ms. Skates and Ms. Lindholm 4th grade, Ms. Taylor 5th grade, Ms. Holbrook 6th grade, Mr. Ferron is our new Intervention Specialist, and Mr. Zimmerman is our new music teacher. We also have a new school psychologist, Dr. Goodwin and two new Instructional Assistants, Ms. Perry and Ms. Goodwill.

School begins for the students in grades 1-6 on Wednesday, August 23, 2023. These students will follow a regular schedule from 8:45-3:30. For the kindergarten students, orientation information and schedules will be mailed separately. It is very important for students to arrive in school *ON TIME daily*, so that our children will develop lifelong skills of punctuality and promptness. Our students' attendance is crucial to our ability to educate and help establish our school environment in order to support academic excellence.

Every family should receive a mailing, which includes: bus schedules and emergency enrollment forms. Please complete these forms and return them to school on the first day. The Lunch Program will begin on the first day of school, **Wednesday**, **August 23**, **2023**.

Breakfast and Lunch is FREE for all students this year. Milk is \$.50 each per day if purchased separately. The breakfast program starts at 8:45 on Wednesday, August 23, 2023. Breakfast is the most important meal of the day!

UNIFORM POLICY: Hamilton is a uniform school (see attachment with specific details). The uniform policy will be enforced up to and including being sent home.

It is very important for students to arrive in school ON TIME daily, so that our children will develop lifelong skills of punctuality and promptness. Attendance is crucial for our ability to educate and help establish our school environment in order to support academic excellence.

Ohio schools are expected to notify the court about students who have multiple unexcused absences and all students' attendance will be monitored very closely. Early dismissals also count against student absences as now absences are calculated by hours, as opposed to days! Research shows a strong correlation between consistent attendance and academic success. The instructional school day is 9:00-3:30. It is essential that every child is at school on time (8:45 for breakfast) and stays until the end of the day (3:30) so that crucial teaching and learning time is not missed. If students are not in their classrooms at 9:00, they will be marked tardy! If you would need to pick up your child early, please call the office prior to 2:30 so that preparations can be made for dismissal. Pick up/transportation requests may not be honored after 3:00, and students will need to remain in school until 3:30 dismissal.

On the first day of school each child will receive a STUDENT-PARENT HANDBOOK. Parents are asked to read the HANDBOOK along with their child, discuss it, and keep it available for use throughout the year. The School Calendar is listed on the back of the HANDBOOK.

On Tuesday, August 22, 2023 we will have a *Parent Information* meeting at 3:15 P.M. on Zoomhttps://ccsoh-us.zoom.us/j/2183225509: (Title I information and academic updates) followed by an ice-cream social from 4:00-5:00 P.M. to welcome our families. We truly want to encourage each of you to continue to be involved in your child's education!

Throughout the school year, should you have questions, please feel free to contact the main office. It is our goal to maximize the instructional school day and would prefer to meet prior to the start of the school day or after dismissal. If you would like to conference with the administrative team or teachers, please call in advance so that arrangements can be made for a time that is conducive for all. We value your concerns and feedback and want to be able to dedicate time to work in collaboration for success. Our school secretaries, **Ms. Wright**, and I will be happy to assist you!
