Note: The answer you give above will help determine what services you or your child may be eligible to receive under the McKinney-Vento Act. Students who are protected under the Act are entitled to the following:

- a) Receive a free, appropriate public education
- b) Enroll in school immediately, even if lacking documents normally required for enrollment
- c) Enroll in the local school, or continue attending their school of origin (the school they attended when permanently housed or the school in which they were last enrolled)
- d) Receive transportation to and from the school of origin
- e) Receive educational services comparable to those provided to other students, according to each student's need
