School Supplies for 2021-2022 School Year



*Supply lists were created in the spring of 2021, with the intention that students will need their own individual supplies, rather than sharing community supplies. With that in mind, please label all your child's supplies with his/her name.

*Please notify the school if you would benefit from assistance with school supplies.

Kindergarten and First Grade

- (1) pack fat Crayola or Roseart markers
- (1) box Crayola or Roseart crayons, box of 24
- (4) glue sticks
- (2) two-pocket folders
- Headphones- over the ear style (not earbuds); clearly labeled with child's name
- Tissues
- Book bag/Backpack- large enough to carry items home (the tiny bags are very cute but if they won't hold a full sized folder, they likely are too small)
- Lunch Box (optional as all students are eligible for Free Lunch)
- Extra set of clothes, in a bag, labeled with child's name, in case of accident
- (2) black dry erase markers
- (1) pack of sharpened pencils
- First grade only: (1) pack plain copy paper
- Kindergarten only: disinfectant cleaning wipes

Second and Third Grade

- Ticonderoga brand pencils (pre-sharpened), box of 12
- (2) wide ruled composition books (black cover with 100 pages)
- (1) Folder- write child's name in upper right-hand corner with Sharpie and write Friday Folder under your child's name
- (1) box sharpened colored pencils
- (1) box crayons
- (1) box markers
- (1) cloth or plastic (not hard plastic box) pencil bag with child's name
- Over ear wired headphones, good quality, not earbuds
- Donation appreciated: one pack of white printer paper

Fourth Grade

- 48 pencils, Ticonderoga are ideal
- Pencil cap erasers
- (2) homework/Friday folders, any design
- (2) wide-ruled composition notebooks (can be spiral)
- (1) 12-pack of colored pencils
- (4) black dry-erase markers
- (1-2) jumbo-sized Elmer's glue sticks (the brand does matter as the others do not work well)

(2) black Sharpies- one fine point, one super fine point
(1) pencil box to hold supplies
(1) handheld pencil sharpener with cover
Headphones or earbuds for school use
(1) box tissues
Columbus Metropolitan library card

Fifth Grade

(1) box tissues
(1) package of 6 or more dry erase markers
(3+) fine and ultra fine black Sharpies
Pencils, as many as you can manage, sharpened preferred
(3) three prong, two pocket folders
(1) box skinny markers
(1) box colored pencils
(2-3) glue sticks
Personal pencil sharpener
Handheld fat eraser
(2) composition books
Earbuds or headphones
Personal reusable water bottle

Middle School Multiple Disabilities Classrooms

(1) pack pencils (suggested Ticonderoga)
(1-2) boxes tissues or individual for desk
(2-4) glue sticks
(2) pink erasers
Markers (basic colors, please)
Colored pencils
Hand sanitizer- you can send individual for the desk
Key lock (send in both keys)
School supply box (plastic, closable)
*All items will be stored in their supply box inside of their desk or locker. A note will be sent home when your student has run out of a supply.
