Families of Indianola students identified as gifted and talented,

I would like to share with you the gifted and talented service plan Indianola will utilize for the 19-20 school year. This information should be considered as you determine the choice you make on the service letter mailed to you from the Gifted and Talented office earlier this month.

**Third graders** with gifted identifications of superior cognitive, math and reading, or reading will receive pull-out **reading instruction** with the gifted intervention specialist to total 300 minutes per week. This is about sixty minutes per day.

**Third graders** with gifted identifications of superior cognitive, math and reading, or math will receive pull-out **math instruction** with the gifted intervention specialist to total 300 minutes per week. This is about sixty minutes per day.

**Fourth graders** with gifted identifications of superior cognitive, math and reading, or reading will receive pull-out **English language arts instruction** with the gifted intervention specialist to total 450 minutes per week. This is about ninety minutes per day.

**Fourth graders** with gifted identifications of superior cognitive, math and reading, or math will receive pull-out **math instruction** with the gifted intervention specialist to total 300 minutes per week. This is about sixty minutes per day.

**Fifth graders** with gifted identifications of superior cognitive, math and reading, or reading will receive pull-out **reading instruction** with the gifted intervention specialist to total 225 minutes per week. This is about forty-five minutes per day.

**Fifth graders** with gifted identifications of superior cognitive, math and reading, or math will receive pull-out **math instruction** with the gifted intervention specialist to total 300 minutes per week. This is about sixty minutes per day. This is the same as what we provided this year.

**Sixth graders** with gifted identifications of superior cognitive, math and reading, or math will receive pull-out **math instruction** with the gifted intervention specialist to total 225 minutes per week. This is about forty-five minutes per day. This is the same as what we provided this year.

I am proud of the work we do with all of our learners and the work we do to meet the needs of each child. I believe this plan is a reflection of this. If you have questions please reach out to me.

If you would like your child to access gifted services at Indianola as described here, please complete your gifted service form as follows and return it to the Gifted & Talented office by March 30. Gifted services requires that you opt in which means you must return your service letter.

- Students who are identified as gifted in reading and math and/or superior cognitive have the choice to 1.) Attend CGA, 2.) Stay at Indianola to receive our services, which is math and reading pullout every day for third, fourth, and fifth grades, or 3.) Stay at Indianola without G/T services
- Students who are identified in reading only or math only have the choice to: 1.) Stay at Indianola and receive our services, which is math pullout or reading pullout, according to the child's identification, every day for third, fourth, and fifth grades, and sixth grade math, or 2.) stay at Indianola without G/T services.

If you have already submitted your form to the Gifted and Talented office and would like to change your selection, please contact the Gifted and Talented office at 614-365-6626 and speak with the secretary before March 29. She will provide you a copy of your original form to make the change.
