

## Mifflin High School Campus Wear Uniform & Dress Code 2018-2019

Mifflin High School requires that ALL students dress according to the Campus Wear uniform policy. The goal of this policy is to provide a professional dress environment aligning to the District's mission to create a climate in which each and every student learns.

### **REQUIREMENTS:**

**Color: KHAKI only.**  
Material: Cotton or Twill.  
Pants must be fitted properly, hemmed, and worn at the waist.  
Skirt and shorts length must be at the top of the knee or longer, and may **not** be tight-fitted.

### **PANTS & SKIRTS**



### **NOT ALLOWED:**

Jeans, Denim, corduroy, sweat pants, wind pants, pajama pants, yoga pants, stretch pants are **not** allowed.  
Spirit Wear days still REQUIRE students to wear KHAKI pants.  
**No sweatpants** or Athletic Team pants or dance skirts are permitted.

### **Shirts, Jackets, Sweaters, Sweatshirts**

### **REQUIREMENTS:**

**Color: Royal Blue, Dark Blue, Black, Grey ONLY.**

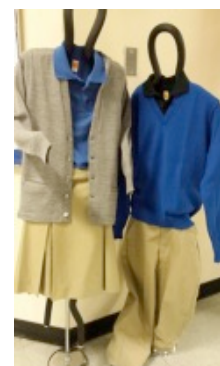
**Must be solid in color. NO writing or symbols not related to Mifflin.** Any logo must be smaller than a business card in size.

**Style: MUST** have a **COLLAR** with either short sleeves or long sleeves. Polo or oxford type is the required look.

Sweaters may be V-neck, crew neck, or cardigan and **must have a shirt with a collar underneath.**

Sweatshirts may be with hoods or crew neck but **MUST** have a shirt with a collar underneath.

Spirit Wear Days do permit Mifflin HS and Mifflin Pride writing, phrases, or Athletic Uniform tops, Jerseys.



### **Shoes, Hats, Hijabs, Belts**

**Shoes:** No open toed, no flip flops or slides. **No hats or other non-religious headcoverings** are permitted inside the building. **Hijabs:** Must be solid in the same colors as shirt requirements. **Belts** should be worn to keep pants at the waist.

**CAMPUS WEAR MUST BE WORN AND TUCKED IN UNDER ALL SWEATERS AND SWEATSHIRTS**

<b>SHOES</b>	<b>No open toed shoes, No flip flops, No slippers, No Slides</b>
<b>Belts</b>	<b>Any solid color must be worn with clothing with belt loops</b>
<b>Ties</b>	<b>Neckties/Bow Ties optional Must be solid Blue/Black</b>
<b>Head Gear</b>	<b>No Head Gear - Caps, hats, sweatbands, bandanas, hair scarfs or other non-erligious head coverings are to be worn inside.</b>
<b>Jewelry</b>	<b>No Heavy metal chains allowed</b>
<b>Spirit Days</b>	<b>Spirit Days may be designated by building principal</b>
<b>Socks</b>	<b>Must be solid in color – black, blue, brown, white.</b>
<b>Hijabs</b>	<b>Must be solid in color: Black, Royal Blue, Navy Blue, Grey</b>

No oversized, tattered, dirty clothing will be permitted. No profanity, offensive language, illustrations, sexual innuendos or references to alcohol, drugs or tobacco are permitted. Undergarments shall not be exposed. No see-through clothing permitted. No outerwear shall be worn inside. Any special needs variations to campus wear policy must be approved by medical or IEP authorization.
