The COVID-19 Pfizer Vaccine Clinics are open to anyone ages 12 and older:

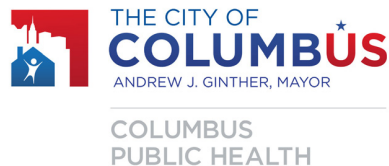
- CCS students and family members

- South High School – Friday, June 19, 7:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.
- West High School – Friday, June 19, 1 to 7 p.m.

All clinics are first come, first-served. If your student is in a CCS summer school, transportation will be available during the school day, and parents are not required to attend. Transportation may be available for all other students and families from select locations. There will be chances to win prizes.
