Oakland Park Traditional Alternative School is a Title 1 School and we pride ourselves by providing your child with a high-quality education. As a Title 1 School, we must meet federal rules related to teacher qualifications as defined by the Every Student Succeeds Act. These rules allow you to learn more about your child's teachers qualifications and credentials. We are happy to provide you with this information.

**Parent's Right To Know- Section 1112(e)(1)(A)**

**Qualifications:** At the beginning of each school year, the district & schools notify the parents of each student in any Title I buildings that they may request information regarding the professional qualifications of their student's classroom teachers, including the following:

- Whether the teacher has met State qualification and licensing criteria for the grade levels and subject areas taught;
- Whether the teacher is teaching under emergency or provisional status through which State qualifications or licensing criteria are waived;
- Whether the teacher is teaching in the field of discipline of the certification or degree; and
- Whether the student is provided services by paraprofessionals and, if so, their qualifications

In addition, parents may request, with respect to such student:

- information on the level of achievement and academic growth of student on each of the state academic assessments required; and
- timely notice that the student has been assigned or has been taught for 4 or more consecutive weeks by a teacher who does not meet applicable State certifications or licensure requirements as the grade level and subject area in which the teacher has been assigned.
