Vrumi, a similar company that was founded in 2015, says it has 5,000 registered users, and Breather, which first launched in Canada in 2013, now also operates in the U.S. and England.

The sharing model is similar to Airbnb, which was founded in 2008. With Airbnb, people can rent out all or part of their homes by the night. The hosts may or may not be home at the time.

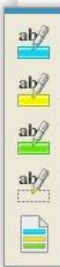

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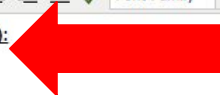
