Regarding the appropriate dress code policy, South HS has shirts available for purchase. Order forms are available in the main office upon request.

- Males must wear khaki or black plats, a white or black shirt (their shirt will be tucked in at all times), a belt, socks and shoes. **SAGGING PANTS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED. NO JEANS, NO RED SHOES.**
- Females must wear khaki or black pants, long skirts, knee length skirts, or knee length jumpers, a white or black shirt with a standard collar, a belt, socks, hose or tights and shoes. **NO FORM FITTED (TIGHT) PANTS OR SKIRTS WILL BE PERMITTED. NO JEANS, NO RED SHOES.**
- **NO RED OF ANY KIND (i.e. belts shoe strings, etc.)**
- NO Hoodies, Jackets or Outerwear of ANY kind can be worn in the building during the school day.
- **IF YOU ARE ASSIGNED TO PEAK AND OR PALS YOU MUST BE IN DRESS CODE**
