




WHAT'S YOUR PATH TO GRADUATION?

In Ohio, there are now more ways to prove you're ready to graduate high school and start a successful and productive life in college, at a job, or in the military.

PICK YOUR PATHWAY: You have multiple pathways to qualify for a high school diploma, in addition to meeting the credit requirements set by the Columbus Board of Education.









COLUMBUS REQUIREMENTS

To earn a high school **Diploma of Graduation** from Columbus City Schools, a student must first successfully complete all course requirements.





INDUSTRY CREDENTIAL WORKFORCE READINESS

WORKKEYS TEST



Students must earn AT LEAST THREE POINTS on each section of the test:

- Applied Mathematics
- Workplace Documents
- Graphic Literacy

Class of 2019:

must earn a minimum score of 13.

Class of 2020/2021:

must earn minimum a score of 14.

CLASS OF 2019

- Take all SEVEN OHIO STATE TEST (OST) end-of-course exams.

 Score 2 or less on any Math or English Language Arts test and you must retake the test at least once.
 - Meet at least **TWO** of the following options:
- 93% attendance 12th-grade year
- 2.5 Grade Point Average 12th-grade year (must complete four full-year courses)
- Senior Capstone Project
- Complete 120 hours of work or community service experience 12th-grade year
- Earn 3 or more College Credit Plus credits
- Earn credit and earn 3 on AP exam
- Earn credit and earn 4 on IB exam
- Earn 3 on each of three WorkKeys sections
- Earn 3 points of State Board-approved industry credentials
- Meet OhioMeansJobs Readiness Seal requirements











CLASS OF 2020

- Take all SEVEN OHIO STATE TEST (OST) end-of-course exams.

 Score 2 or less on any Math or English Language Arts test and you must retake the test at least once.
 - Meet at least **TWO** of the following options:
- 2.5 Grade Point Average for 11th and 12th-grade years (must complete four full-year courses each year)
- Senior Capstone Project
- Complete 120 hours of work or community service experience 12th-grade year
- Earn 3 or more College Credit Plus credits
- Earn credit and earn 3 on AP exam
- Earn credit and earn 4 on IB exam
- Earn 3 on each of three WorkKeys sections
- Earn 3 points of State Board-approved industry credentials
- Meet OhioMeansJobs Readiness Seal requirements

ONLY AVAILABLE FOR CLASS OF 2019 AND CLASS OF 2020

- Take all **SEVEN OHIO STATE TEST** (OST) end-of-course exams.
- Finish CAREER-TECHNICAL PROGRAM that includes at least FOUR courses in a single career pathway.

Meet at least **ONE** of the following options:

- Earn a total score of PROFICIENT based on all career-technical exams or test modules.
- Earn an industry credential equal to 12 points.
- Complete a workplace experience totaling 250 hours with evidence of positive evaluations.




