	Send your ACT/SAT scores to colleges . Many colleges will NOT accept scores on your transcripts as official scores (including OSU). It can take several weeks for the scores to arrive after you order them. Start ordering them now, if you haven't done so already and Pre-order scores when you sign up for any future ACT/SAT tests.	
	Start Writing Your Application Essays - Have 3 adults read it before you add it to your applications	
	Proofread, Proofread. Before you submit your applications: Have your School Counselor and/or your IKIC advisor look over your applications with you before you submit them	
	Plan for Application Fees: IKIC App Payments: IKIC will pay for up to 3 of your application fees (regardless of income). IKIC payments are NOT the same as waivers. See Mrs. Uniacke for more details. Fee Waivers (Based on Income): If you qualify for ACT/SAT & Instructional Fee Waivers, you may qualify for application fee waivers too. You have to fill out the Fee Waiver application every year, make sure you have one on file for the 2018-2019 school year. Talk to your school counselor for more information.
