

ANNUAL PUBLIC NOTICE OF CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION OPPORTUNITIES

Each year, the Columbus City School District offers career and technical education (CTE) programs throughout the district. Career and technical education programs are open to all 7-12 grade students in Columbus City Schools regardless of sex, race, color, national origin, religion, age, disability, sexual orientation, gender identity/expression, ancestry, familial status or military status. Students who are interested in a CTE program offered at comprehensive middle or high schools or career centers enroll through their home middle or high schools as part of the course selection process. For programs that reach capacity, students are put on a waitlist on a first-come, first-serve basis and placed if an opening in the program becomes available. CTE programs are designed to prepare youth for a broad range of careers and post-secondary opportunities and are offered under the guidance of certified teachers. The following is a list of programs being offered this year and criteria for participation in work-based learning experiences in the programs.

All CTE programs follow the district's nondiscrimination policies with regard to admission, access, treatment or employment in all programs and activities. Students with disabilities or ESL needs are provided supports to ensure that all students have access to their chosen CTE educational pathway.
