


## Student devices

There are only 2 apps students need to use until the teachers tell them differently.






## Columbus Online Academy K-8 Daily Expectations

- Attend all scheduled zoom classes.
  - This includes any one on one or small group zoom sessions.
- Be on time for zoom classes.
- Complete all assigned work in a timely manner.
  - If you need assistance, please let your teacher know and they can schedule office hours to help.
- Have your camera on.
  - We need to see each student so we know who is doing the learning, and in the primary grades, we will need to see their learning.
- Microphones should be muted unless you are asked to share.
- Use the raised hand emoji when you have a question or want to share.
- If chat is open, it is for responding to the teachers questions, it is not for chatting with other students, and should never be used to hurt the feelings of your classmates or teachers.
- Online school is still school, everyone should have a safe and quiet as possible location
  - away from a TV and toys
  - o in an area dedicated to school work with all school materials located within arms reach
  - not in bed is best (this keeps them from trying to go back to sleep)
  - students still need to follow the CCS dress code in the Guide to Student Conduct.
- Please remember, we can hear everything happening in your home, so adult behaviors should be away from your child's learning area if possible please.

## Columbus Online Academy K-8 Flexibility

Flexibility is one of the many benefits students and families have with attending an online school.

We ask that everyone keep the following in mind when it comes to flexibility:

#### Flexibility is:

- Keeping your teacher informed if you can not attend class.
- Making up all work missed with in 48 hours.
- Keeping your teachers informed of any learning needs.
- Completing assignments in a timely manner.
- Working in the evenings, on the weekends, or even over school breaks and notifying your teacher of:
  - How much time you spent working
  - What you did during that time.
- Keeping the teachers and office informed of days missed.

#### Flexibility is NOT:

- Coming and going from classes for fun.
- Not participating in class.
- Turning in everything at the end of the month or quarter.
- Working after hours and not informing the teacher.

## Columbus Online Academy K-8 Attendance

Attendance looks different for COA. Student attendance is based off the following:

- Attending all scheduled Zoom classes
- Completing all assigned work
- Completing lessons in iReady
- With teacher permission completing assignments outside of the school day and then reporting your time spent to the teacher
- Attending Music, Art, Physical Education classes
- Attending testing days
- Participating in the in person learning sessions
- Please pack a lunch for testing days
- Have your device fully charged

#### **Important update:**

Ohio Revised Code requires us to notify you if your student is not participating in school activities after missing 30 hours. If your child misses 72 consecutive hours, they will be unenrolled from COA and placed in a traditional building based on available space.

## Columbus Online Academy K-8 Testing Expectations

Students are required to come into a testing location to take their tests.

Sign up genius will be used so you can select your testing date and time.

This year we are going to try to make testing times a full day (9 am to 2 pm) to allow teachers to have time to work with students in person to help with hands on work and catching up on missing work.

If you have any questions about the testing sign ups or need to see if alternative arrangements can be made, please reach out to the office and we will connect you with Mrs. Hampton. She is our coach and she will will assist you with your testing needs.

## Columbus Online Academy K-8 8th Grade Expectation

All students in grade 8 will leave with:

- → 1.5 credits toward High School Graduation. These will come from the following:
  - .5 PE credit
  - ◆ 1 music tech or 1 art credit
  - Must earn a grade of D or higher.
- → 10 internship hours
  - ♦ Students need 120 internship hours to graduate.
- → A schedule for 9th grade
- → A 4 year graduation plan
